Changes to Conclusion of Prayers at Mass: The Bishops of England and Wales have asked us to amend missals with prayers ending with “one” God to omit this as it is not a direct translation from the Latin and can cause confusion.

The instructions are:

“ As indicated in the Decree, and in harmony with the adjacent English-speaking territories of Scotland and Ireland, as well as with other English-speaking territories, the Catholic Bishops’ Conference of England and Wales has decided to delete “one” from the conclusion of the Collect prayers of the Roman Missal, and that this change would come into effect from the First Sunday of Advent 2020.

The second part of n. 54 in the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* is to be adjusted as follows:

- If the prayer is directed to the Father: *Through our Lord Jesus Christ your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever;*
- If the prayer is directed to the Father, but the Son is mentioned at the end: *Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever;*
- If the prayer is directed to the Son: *Who live and reign with God the Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.*

John Endicott RIP: Please pray for the repose of the soul of our beloved John. His funeral will take place in our church on Tuesday the 24th of November at 1:00pm. The family will organise a remembrance service, sometime next year when the restrictions are relaxed so many people may be able to attend.

Gill Hanson RIP: Please pray for the repose of the soul of our beloved Gill. Her funeral will take place in our church, on Wednesday the 25th of November at 1:00pm. As space is limited to 30 people on the day, it is not possible for parishioners to attend. It is hoped to that we will remember Gill sometime in the new year with a remembrance service when more people can get together.

Gill will be received into church on Tuesday the 24th of November at about 4:00pm where parishioners are encouraged to come and pay their respects. The church will be open till 5:00pm.
