From 2011 - 2018, he was a co-moderator for the Florida Table, a networking group that is associated with the Hampton Table in Los Angeles. He was also instrumental in the opening of a Table group in Atlanta, GA. In 2023, Richard changed the name of the group to Florida Arts Network and incorporated it as a 501c3 non-profit. Aside from running his own company, Richard is also on the Board of Directors for the FLOW Film Festival.

In addition to his passion for acting, Richard enjoys working on the other side of the camera. He has been sought out as a set coach, consultant, and a producer for

several independent film projects that have shot in South Florida. He is very involved in the local film community and has been interviewed on both television and radio for his work as an advocate for the Florida film industry. Richard also likes to write. He is an award-winning writer and is currently in talks with an independent production company for a script he co-authored that deals with human trafficking.
