SUMMARY

Paint components of structures used in various applications subjected to various weather elements using high pressure, high volume spray equipment. Prepare metal surfaces for painting by sandblasting or sanding and cleaning surfaces. May mix paints to achieve desired colors or order paints to meet customers specifications.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Plans production operations, establishing priorities, and sequences for finishing operations.
- Reviews production schedules and related information and confers with supervisor to determine material requirements, delivery requirements, and efficient shop utilization.
- Requisitions material and establishes sequential delivery dates to job sites, according to job order priorities and material availability.
- Computes amount of material or computerized records such as material inventory, quality control, in process production reports, and status and location of materials.
- Cleans grease and dirt from product.
- Removes rust and mill scale from metal with Pangborn shot basting equipment or manual hand operations.
- Maintains sandblasting and shot blasting machines.
- Applies masking tape over parts and areas that are not to be coated.
- Understands the equipment used, the products used, the product coding and the spraying style to paint the varieties of structures built by Aura Fabricators Inc.
- Maintains inventory of supplies and products and either notify supervisor of need to order or order product in their absence.
- Pulls trigger and directs spray onto work surface to apply prime or finish coat.
- Coats areas inaccessible to hand sprayer with brush.
- Performs touch ups on light areas, handling marks, or other flaws with brush or roller.
- Cleans spraying equipment and brushes with solvent.
- Cleans around work areas.
- Follows procedures and sequences so products are completed and loaded in a way that allows construction crews to follow proper construction sequences.
- Performs visual welding, coating, and distortional inspections of product.
- Documents and records quality inspections and results.
