SUMMARY

Welds, fabricates and assembles miscellaneous, ornamental and structural components such as ornamental railings, stairs, ladders, overhead sign structures, machinery frames, and building and bridge parts by performing the following duties.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Perform FCAW, GMAW, and/or SAW welding on a variety of metals, primarily on steel but occasionally on aluminum or stainless steel. Candidates will be certified to appropriate AWS welding certifications.
- Operate welding and fabrication equipment safely and efficiently.
- Sets up and operates fabricating machines such as welding machines, brakes, saws, rollers, shears, flame cutters, and drill presses
- Operate power and hand tools, such as grinders, drills, and saws
- Safely operate forklifts, overhead cranes and other material handling equipment
- Verifies conformance of workpiece to shop drawings
- Develop layout and plans sequence of operations
- Designs and constructs templates and fixtures
- Preheat workpieces
- Assembles parts by welding, bolting and/or riveting
- Repairs products by following weld procedures, dismantling, straightening, reshaping, and reassembling parts
- Locates and marks bending and cutting lines onto workpiece
- Hammers, chips, and grinds workpiece to cut, bend, and straighten metal
- Adds coolant to reservoirs of machines and lubricates machine parts
- Removes metal chips and shavings from surfaces of machines and wipes surfaces of machines to remove excess oil.
- Deburrs or polishes parts
- Separates metal shavings, chips, and scrap materials from trash and places them in bins for resale
- Cleans around work areas
- Cleans interior surfaces of holes
- Changes tools on powered equipment
