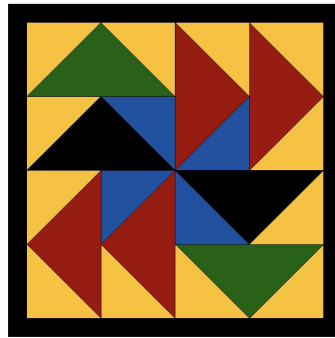


Quilting with African Fabric for Kwanzaa by Kena Tangi Dorsey



(36 1/2" x 36 1/2")

DESCRIPTION: Using African Wax Print Fabrics to create a Kwanzaa Holiday themed Wall Hanging

FABRICS NEEDED:

- Black African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Yellow Solid or Print: 3/4 Yard or (3) Fat Quarters
- Red African Wax Print: (2) Fat Quarters
- Green African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Blue African Wax Print: (1) Fat Quarter
- Black Solid or Print: 3/8 Yard or (4) 2 1/2" strips WOF

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: (finished size of Flying Geese Blocks are 8 3/4" x 16 3/4")

- CUT 12 - YELLOW SQUARES 8 7/8" x 8 7/8"
- CUT 4 - BLUE SQUARES 8 7/8" x 8 7/8"
- CUT 4 - RED RECTANGLES 8 7/8" x 16 7/8"
- CUT 2 - GREEN RECTANGLES 8 7/8" x 16 7/8"
- CUT 2 - BLACK RECTANGLES 8 7/8" x 16 7/8"
- CUT 4 - BLACK 2 1/2" by WOF

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. On the wrong side of all twelve YELLOW 8 7/8" squares, draw a guideline from corner to corner.
2. On the wrong side of all four BLUE 8 7/8" squares, draw a guideline from corner to corner.
3. Place one YELLOW square right side down on a GREEN 8 7/8" x 16 7/8" rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step with another YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
4. Place one YELLOW square right side down on a RED 8 7/8" x 16 7/8" rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step with another YELLOW square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
5. Place one YELLOW square right side down on the left side a RED 8 7/8" x 16 7/8" rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step but with a BLUE square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
6. Place one YELLOW square right side down on the left side of a BLACK 8 7/8" x 16 7/8" rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim 1/4" from the seam. Repeat this step but with a BLUE square on the other side. Press out. (Make 2 of this flying geese combination)
7. TRIM all Flying Geese blocks to measure 8 1/2" x 16 1/2"
8. Arrange the flying geese blocks using the color and direction pattern pictured above. Sew the blocks together using a 1/4" seam allowance.
9. Sew one BLACK strip to the left and one to the right side of the quilt, and one BLACK strip to the top and one along the bottom.
