

# Collection Services For Del Webb The Woodlands



**WM is proud to serve the residents of Del Webb The Woodlands. Below is your service information and guidelines.**

## Service Schedule and Guidelines

### Trash Collection: Tuesday

- Please only use your WM 96-gallon cart (green lid) WM for household waste, grass clippings, leaves, branches, and tree trimmings.
- No material outside the cart will be collected.
- Please be sure your waste cart is out by 7 a.m. on collection day.

### Recycling Collection: every other Tuesday.

- Please only use your WM 96-gallon cart (yellow lid).
- Please place recyclables directly into your cart and break down cardboard.
- Do not bag recyclables and keep loose plastic bags out of your cart.
- No material outside the cart will be collected.

- Please be sure your waste cart is out by 7 a.m. on collection day.

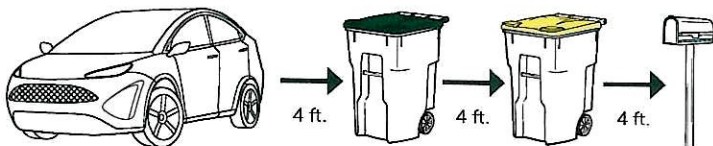
## Holiday Schedule

Please note, if a holiday occurs on or before your waste collection day, your waste pickup will be delayed one day that week.

## Proper Cart Placement

Place your cart at the curb with the wheels facing the house and at least 4 feet apart and 4 feet away from trees, cars, and mailboxes.



## Bulk Item Collection

**Bulk Collection:** first Tuesday of every month.

### Acceptable items include:

- Moving boxes (please break down and bundle them)
- Old furniture
- Grass clippings
- Appliances
- Leaves, branches and tree trimmings

These items are collected monthly, outside the cart.

### Non-Acceptable Items Include:

- Gasoline & oil (cans/filters)
- Large pieces of metal
- Lithium batteries
- Propane tanks
- Vehicle tires
- Landscape rock
- Hazardous chemicals
- Construction debris (i.e. paint & carpet)
- Electronic waste (i.e. televisions/computer monitors)
- Glass (i.e. windows, bathroom mirrors resulting from construction projects)

**Important:** To ensure the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we require that branches and tree trimmings have a maximum diameter of three (3) inches. They should be cut, tied, and bundled into lengths of four (4) feet and must not weigh more than 50 pounds.

**Please note:** WM can no longer dispose of CFC refrigerant containing items (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.) without certification that the Freon has been properly removed and recycled, pursuant to current Federal law.
