PREAMBLE 1

(read by a friend in recovery)



Pagans in Recovery (PiR) is a 12 Step/12 Tradition fellowship based on the example pioneered by Alcoholics Anonymous. Our wish is to assure people seeking recovery that they can recover without having to accept anyone else's beliefs or to deny their own. We welcome people who follow alternative spiritual paths, including those who worship or work with one or more Goddesses, Gods, Spirits, Energies, Powers, or Ancestors, and whose spirituality may include magical practices.

PIR does not seek any conflict or controversy. Nor are we are allied with any sect, denomination, politics, organization, or institution. Our primary purpose is to help one another and ourselves to achieve and maintain recovery. Pagans in Recovery is not specific to any individual Twelve-Step program, nor do we wish to compete with or replace any of them. Rather, PiR is available to all who need it, to be used in conjunction with the Twelve Step programs we individually are involved in. Because of this diversity of our community we define recovery in multiple ways. As such, the recovery language used in our meetings, for example "sobriety" is left up to each individual.

PREAMBLE 2

(read by a friend in recovery)



The format for this meeting is an Open, 12 Step Discussion-based, Pagans in Recovery Meeting, and is open to all 12-step fellowships. We seek to get back to basics and foster connection with other pagans in Recovery, providing a place of calm and safety for people to get (and stay) inspired and hopeful in their Recovery. The chairperson will select a topic, reading, or other inspiration along these lines, share on it, and then the meeting will be open for general discussion.

PIR A.B.C. meets Wednesdays at 8PM Eastern Standard Time. Pagans in Recovery has meetings every day of the week, and you can find the meeting schedule at pagansinrecovery.org

THE 12 STEPS

(read by a friend in recovery)



- (1) We admitted we were powerless over our addiction; that our lives had become unmanageable.
- (2) Came to believe that Powers greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
- (3) Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of our Gods as we understood them.
- (4) Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
- (5) Admitted to our Gods, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs
- (6) Were entirely ready to have our Gods remove all these defects of character.
- (7) Humbly asked our Higher Powers to remove our shortcomings.
- (8) Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.
- (9) Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
- (10) Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.
- (11) Sought through prayer, meditation, and our craft to improve our conscious contact with our Higher Powers (as we understand them), praying only for the knowledge of their Will for us and the power to carry that out.
- (12) Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these steps, we tried to carry this message to others, and to practice these principles in all our affairs.

MEETING ANNOUNCEMENTS

(read by the trusted servant)



[STOP SCREEN SHARE]

- -Since Pagans in Recovery includes people recovering in all fellowships, not just drugs and alcohol, we ask that you refrain from eating, smoking, drinking, or any other disruptive behaviors while on camera. If necessary, please turn off your camera temporarily.

GROUP UNITY POLICY

(read by the trusted servant)



In order to maintain an atmosphere of recovery and to maintain unity within PIR, the group asks everyone attending to refrain from aggressive and disruptive behavior of any kind during this meeting. The chairperson may ask you to stop the disruptive behavior. If you do not, you may be temporarily kicked out of the meeting for that day. Repeat and egregious offenses may lead to banning. It is vitally important that we respect each other and this virtual space in order to maintain a safe space for all of those in recovery. Please let the chairperson know privately if anyone is harassing you.

DISCUSSION TOPIC

(read by the trusted servant)

Please be mindful of your time while sharing so that everyone has a chance to share. If this topic doesn't resonate with you, please feel free to share on whatever is on your heart and mind.

5 MINUTES TO CLOSE

(read by the trusted servant)



Does anyone have a burning desire, meaning that if you don't share your sobriety may be in jeopardy, or you'll hurt yourself or someone else.
