
- 1. Cut out two identical circles (see below). Cut out the centre of the circles. The centre cut out should be at least half the size of the outside of the circle and wide enough to pass wool and thread through. Stick the paper circles to cardboard. The diameter of the pom pom is governed by the size of the circle.
- 2. Wind some wool off the ball/skein and wind it around all four fingers not too tightly. If you want to use more than one colour you can just wind this on. Do not make the strand of wool too fat as it needs to be able to pass through the centre hole of your circle.
- 3. Start to wind the strand of wool around the two circles passing the wool around the circle and through the centre hole.
- 4. Keep winding around the circle until the circle is covered and then continue winding until no wool could be passed through the centre hole.
- 5.NOTE you may need someone to help you with this stage. Using fabric scissors, cut down into the wool IN BETWEEN the cardboard circles. Holding the circles tightly, cut all around the circles.
- 6.Take a length of wool and wind it very tightly around the pom pom, IN BETWEEN the cards. Pull the wool tightly and knot off.
- 7.Take off the cardboard and trim the pom pom evenly all around.
