## Batting (Wadding)

Batting, or wadding is made of cotton, polyester, wool, or flannel is layered sandwich-style between the quilt top and backing. The three layers are basted or pinned together, and the quilting design is marked on the top and quilted on by sewing machine or by hand.

Batting is the term most often used in America and Wadding in the UK.
