Fell Seams



A fell seam is one where the wrong sides of the fabric are sewn together. On one side the seam is trimmed, and the other seam is folded over the trimmed seam. The seam is then finished by stitching again along the seam line by using the cover stitch on the sewing machine or a chain stitch on the overlocker. Fell seams given additional strength to a garment or bag.
