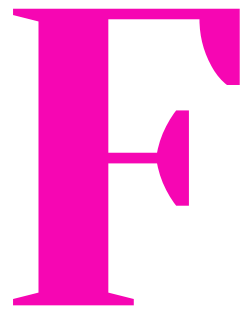


# Foundation Paper Piecing



Foundation Paper-Piecing (sometimes called paper-piecing) is when the outline of a quilt block is printed on a paper foundation and fabric is sewn together on the paper using the outline as a sewing guide. When the block is complete the paper foundation is removed. Accurate piecing is possible with FPP, even with the smallest of pieces. Each foundation paper-pieced block is different, but same basic steps and techniques apply to all.



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
