

Weave structures



The weave of the fabric describes the joining of the warp and weft threads to make fabric. The weave of the fabric makes the final finish in differing fabric types. There are several types of weave:

Plain weave - the basic weave where the warp and weft cross over each other;

Twill - a weave with parallel ribs that run diagonally down the fabric;

Basket weave - a plain weave with a texture like an open weave basket

Satin weave - a plain weave with a shiny side and a matte side;

Ribbed weave - a plain weave with weft threads are larger than warp threads.
