

Zip(per)



A zipper, zip, or zip fastener, is a commonly used device for binding together two edges of fabric or other flexible material. There are four types of zipper:

- Regular - with teeth in the tape on the right side with a puller. Stitching is exposed on the right side.
- Invisible - with teeth in the tape on the wrong side. Stitching is hidden on the wrong side.
- Metal - the teeth and pull stop are made from metal.
- Separating - the zip tape separates completely and is used on jackets or where the zip needs to fully open.
