About the Cleveland Jazz Orchestra

For over 35 years, The Cleveland Jazz Orchestra has been Northeast Ohio's premier jazz voice. Led by Paul Ferguson, the CJO promotes jazz in its historical and contemporary forms, through concerts with gifted jazz musicians, arrangers, composers and educators in northeast Ohio. The CJO aims for worldwide recognition in cooperation with quest artists, and looks to shepherd young musicians toward the future of jazz. This mission and vision are brought to life through a variety of new music, new compositions and arrangements, and a stellar line-up of well-known quest artists and young up-and-coming talent!

About the Cleveland Composers Guild

The Cleveland Composers Guild is one of the nation's oldest new music organizations, and has had over 200 composer members over its more than fifty year history. For over sixty years, the CCG has built an enviable record of supporting new music, with recordings on the CRI, Crystal, Advent, and Capstone labels, and publication series from Ludwig and Galaxy. There are currently about 40 professional composers in the Guild and each concert features a wide range of musical styles. In recent years the Guild has collaborated with many of northeast Ohio's most renowned ensembles and individuals. The Guild has engaged in collaborations with dance, visual arts, and poetry to create multi-disciplinary concerts that engage with the arts in a new way. The CCG produces numerous live concerts every season featuring the finest performers available in Northeast Ohio, and all concerts are free-ofcharge. In addition to regular series programs, the Guild produces an annual Junior Concert – now celebrating its 30th season – in tandem with the Music Settlement in University Circle. Pre-college age students perform music written for them by Guild members and compose original music as well; it's a great way to encourage the next generation of musicians to love new music.
