

Official Contest Rules

NPTBDC Indigenous Housing 1-year Anniversary Open House



1. Eligibility

This contest is open to legal residents of the province of Ontario (Canada) and who are a minimum age of 18 years or older at the time of entry. Employees and Board Members of NPTBDC Indigenous Housing, its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, and immediate family members will not be eligible to win one of the contest prizes.

For this contest, the definition of “immediate family” refers to a person’s closest relatives, which includes parents (biological or adoptive), siblings (brothers, sisters, including half-siblings), children (biological or legally adopted) and spouse (legally married or common-law).

2. Contest Period

The contest will begin on September 15, 2025 and closes on October 30, 2025 at 4:00pm (EST zone). Entries submitted before or after the contest period will not be eligible.

3. How to Enter

To enter the contest, participants must:

- Step 1: Follow the NPTBDC Indigenous Housing official page.
- Step 2: Like and Share the original contest post.
- Step 3: Comment and Tag a friend on original post.

**No purchase is necessary to enter or win a prize.

4. Entry Restrictions

- Limit of one (1) entry per person.
- Duplicate, incomplete, or fraudulent entries will be disqualified.

5. Prizes

The winner(s) will receive one of three prizes as follows: 1st/Grand prize is an iPad (A16) with Smart Folio valued at \$599.00; 2nd/runner up prize is a Vevor 2L Countertop Frozen Drink Maker valued at \$299.99; 3rd place prize is a combination dining gift card valued at \$200.00.

Prizes are non-transferable, and no substitutions or cash redemption will be allowed.

6. Winner Selection and Notification

The winners will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system on October 31, 2025 at 11:00am (EST zone), in order of 3rd prize, then 2nd/runner up prize, and lastly 1st/Grand prize.

Winner(s) will be notified via Facebook direct message and provided with a Security Code for identification purposes. Once a winning name is selected for a prize, it will not be returned to the RNG for subsequent prizes.

The winner must provide his/her name with picture identification confirming resident of Ontario, Canada and the Security Code provided. If the winner cannot provide photo ID and Security Code, then the prize will be held until such identification can be provided.

If the winner does not respond within sixty (60) days, an alternate winner will be selected using RNG.

By entering the contest, participants grant NPTBDC Indigenous Housing the right to use their name, likeness, entry, and submitted content in promotional materials or social media posts without further compensation.

NPTBDC Indigenous Housing reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify the contest if fraud, technical issues, or any other factor beyond its reasonable control impairs the integrity of the contest. Participation constitutes the entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules.

In the unlikely event that the draw is postponed due to technical difficulty, power interruption, emergency or other unforeseen event, NPTBDC Indigenous Housing will remedy the situation, then conduct the draw and announce the winners at the earliest possible opportunity.
