

# Some Helpful Information From Your Hosts

### Hi!

We would like to share some helpful information about your suite, the property and us: Bill and Bobbi Matuk. If you have any questions not answered here, please reach out to us using one of the phone numbers in the green footer below. Use this QR Code for an online version of this document ->

Water and Ice - We have filtered all the water coming into our house and your suite with an Aquasana water filtration system. We have a water dispensing system in the guest hallway that is filtered again. You can fill up your water bottles, the coffee water reservoir, or the carafe we have provided in your room. The dispenser water is room temp, but you can place the carafe in your refrigerator to chill the water. We have provided a small ice tray in your freezer that you can use to make ice for your drinks.

**AC and Heating** - There are 2 remotes in your room for controlling the temperature of your suite. Please reach out to the numbers below if you have any questions about the system.

**TV** – You have one remote for the TV in your room. Your Samsung Smart TV features several viewing options including Live Network TV (ABC, CBS, FOX, NBC), and Samsung Plus TV with over 2,000 channels of broadcasting including music. All programming guides are on screen. You may also enjoy other platforms such as Netflix, Apple TV, HULU, and Prime TV among others while using your personal accounts. You may also cast streaming apps and music from your mobile device to the TV. If you need assistance with this let us know.



Wildlife on the Property – You may encounter some animals on our property ranging from Tule Elk to Brush Rabbits. We ask that you respect local wildlife and keep a distance from them. At any time from your deck, you may see hawks, eagles, crows and turkey vultures soaring through the air. The Red-Tailed Hawks and Bald Eagles are very special, and we hope you can encounter them during your visit. The Tule Elk traverse through our property at various times of the day differing with each season. You will most likely see them from your deck in the early morning or at dusk. Please watch where you walk if you decide to take a stroll around the property or neighborhood. The Central Coast is home to many snakes, and we hope you do not encounter a rattlesnake. Please walk away from all snakes. We would like to keep our "good" snakes on the property that help with the rodent population. Snakes are out from April through October.

**Shared Areas on the Property** – We have a couple seating areas outside the guest door to view the Sunset. You are welcome to make yourself at home and lounge in these areas.

Couleur de la vie Art Studio on the property – You might have noticed a rust-colored storage container on the right, as you parked in the suite parking. This is Bobbi's studio, and garden for her natural dyeing passion job. Bobbi holds workshops and you may find her in the studio dyeing fabrics with flowers and natural pigments.
