• VitalStim Therapy

Today, there is a new treatment available called VitalStim. VitslStim is a specialized form of neuromuscular electrical stimulation designed to treat dysphagia through muscular re-education. VitalStim therapy is the only device and therapy cleared by the FDA to treat dysphagia.





Dysphagia, or difficulty swallowing, affects as many as 15 million Americans and approximately one million new cases are diagnosed each year. Symptoms can include coughing during or after swallowing, choking on food or liquid, the sensation of food getting stuck in the throat, pain during swallowing and shortness of breath while eating. Dysphagia can occur following a stroke, radiation therapy for head and neck cancer, surgery, traumatic head or spinal cord injury and tracheotomy.

It is also common in people with Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, cerebral palsy and COPD
