- . Fr. George has appointed Cathy Berger to help with the Social Action Committee Chaired by Lettie Buchanan.
- . Fr. George has appointed Danielle Caudle as Co-Chair with Aracely Castillo on Family Life Committee.
- . Fr. George has appointed Eli Wright as Youth Representative of the Parish Council.

<u>Olin Yancey</u> - We are supposed to develop a slate of candidates for the Council in the spring, replacing 1/3 of the members each year. That has not been done since I have been in the parish. Therefore I propose this timeline for the coming year.

- • In October 2025, the Council forms a Discernment/Nominating committee.
- • Chair plus 2 to no more than 4
- • 1 of 2 (or 2 of 4) not current Council members
- • Chair not a current Council member
- • By February 2026 the Committee develops a slate of candidates for the coming year (July 2026 June 2027)

- • Selected from recommendations and personal knowledge
- • Known good candidates approached by the Committee, preferably in person
- • First of March 2026
- Announce candidate slate to the Parish from the ambo, in bulletins, Flocknote
- • Solicit nominations from the Parish via any current Council member.
- • Weekend of 2 and 3 May 2026 hold elections after Mass.
- • Paper ballot, vetted from latest registration.
- All parishioners in good standing, 18 or older, in person, no proxies.
- • Tabulate votes and report results to Council at the May meeting.
- Announce members-elect at the next Mass, in bulletin, and "Window"
- • Fr. George commissions new Chairs at 8:30 Sunday Mass prior to July council meeting.
- . July 2026 or first meeting thereafter new Council begins.
