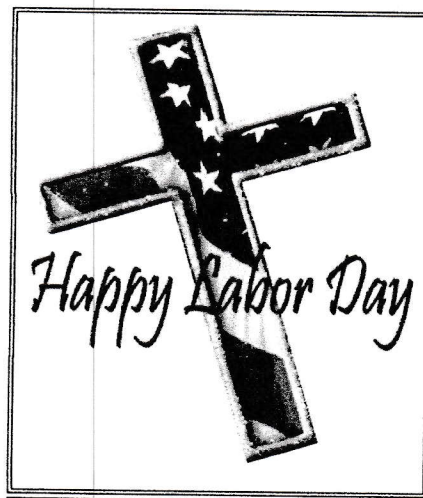

Fr. George Report:

1. **1** From June 1st to 4th, 2026 I had participated in our Annual Diocesan Convocation for the priests of the Diocese of Nashville. The theme of the conference was **"Evangelization"**, specially focusing on Catholic Come Home Program. All enjoyed it. Now I am reaching out to you all my people to help me in welcoming and bringing back the harvest lost ones around our parish to embrace our community.
2. **On 6-14-26 Sunday, we welcomed the Vocation Director of the Diocese of Nashville, Fr. Luke Wilgenbush and nine Seminary students** who visited our parish for their pastoral experience. Fr. Luke presided over the mass and Fr. George co-celebrated with him and the Seminarians served as Acolytes. They were given a reception by the Knights of Columbus and the Hospitality committee combined in St. Josephs' Hall. My sincere thanks to the Knights of Columbus and the Hospitality Committee for the delicious breakfast.
3. I am very happy to let all you that we have completed the updating of the **Security Camera System for tightening the security** of our parish and the church building and ground facilities. I thank sincerely the maintenance chairperson Mr. Dennis Morgan who worked in unison with the Finance Board and the Pastor for this great accomplishment and who will explain to the Committee more details of the project.
4. From June 22 to 26, we conducted the Summer Vacation Bible class (Aloha) for our kids and nearly 27 students were present. The Kids enjoyed the program and they had lots of fun as well. I thank sincerely Mrs. Danielle Caudle and her team for organizing it with an artistic touch for the success of the program. We also organized a **Teen-Lock-in** program also under her leadership, for the teenagers on June 28th & 29th at St. Josephs' Hall. The students enjoyed the event. Thanks to the Family Life chairman Danielle Caudle and her team.
5. **On 7-2-26 being Thursday, Mrs. Julie West** and myself took a tour of visiting all the home-bound in nursing homes, and the ill people of our parish. Distributed Holy Communion, July 4th flowers, and spent a happy time with them. It was a really healing experience.

I am very happy that **our communication system** has taken a new step of extending our facilities like Flock note, our Website, St. Anthony Facebook, Parish Calendar and The Window Newsletter, for which Pat Bronner, Cathy Berger, Parish Secretary, Sherie Jacks and Trisha Tito are working in unison. Evangelization:

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) program begins on Wednesday evening this week. The class materials will be used to teach Catholic beliefs to those potentially interested in changing to the Catholic faith. And those same materials will be utilized as a type of Bible study program for those Catholics wanting to deepen their own faith. Many have been wanting to participate in a Bible study.

Ten people have signed up to participate in this effort to strengthen their faith by evangelizing themselves initially.

FY26/27 Church Budget:

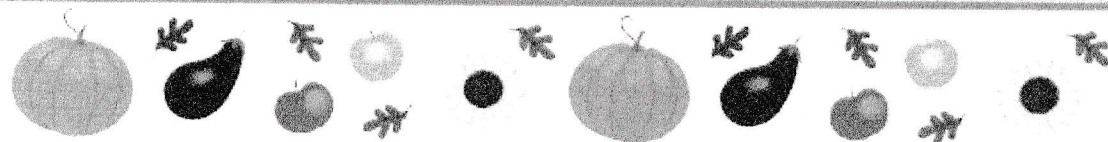
