



SOME ST. ANTHONY HISTORY

The stained glass windows in the church were designed by Father George Mathis, the pastor at the time of the original church construction, the windows were hand crafted by Father Mathis with help from St. Anthony parishioners, Bob Mead, Charlie Gannon, Vic Finch, Bill Mathis, Joe Bonin, Lance Bonin, Bill Mathis, and Fr. John Otterbacher.


The windows were originally located in accordance with a long-standing European tradition. The warm-colored windows were originally located in the eastern side of the building, where the rising sun would flood the church with warm colors in the cool mornings. The cool colors were used in West-facing windows, where the setting sun would cause the church to be illuminated with the cool refreshing blues and greens.




The "Passion" Window - The Passion window in the peak on the west side of the peak of the church is symbolic of Christ's passion. A portion of the cross is seen passing through both sections of the window. The palm frond recalls that on His arrival in Jerusalem, He was greeted with this symbol of reverence by the welcoming mobs. It also reminds us of the olive branch, a symbol of peace. The location at the peak of the church, reminds us that Christ's passion, death, and resurrection are the ultimate events which defined his divinity and are the highest bases for our Christian beliefs.



Tabernacle Windows - The windows on either side of the Tabernacle show us the symbols of wheat and bread, and grapes and wine, which become the Body and blood of Christ in the Eucharist. A fitting remembrance of the presence of Our Lord in the Tabernacle.




Net and Fish Window - The Net and Fish window in the peak on the east side of the peak of the church reminds us of how the Lord gathers us Christians to be his own people, like the fisherman separating the fish from the other things picked up by his net. The chi-rho symbol (The P and the +) are an ancient symbol of Christ, who longs to catch us in his net.



Windows at the Altar - The windows on each side of the altar are an abstract design of color and motion (fire and incense) reminding us of Psalm 141, which suggests like incense, our prayers and lives should rise up to God for His praise and His glory.




Holy Spirit Window - The dove in the Holy Spirit window represents the Holy spirit, and the seven flames represent the gifts of the Spirit to us: Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge, Counsel, Fortitude, Piety, and Fear of the Lord.



St. Anthony Window - The St. Anthony window (above the old front entrance) depicts the patron saint of our church, regarded for his love of the Scriptures (the Book), and the fact that he was a great teacher and preacher of theology. St. Anthony was a Franciscan monk who died in 1231.
