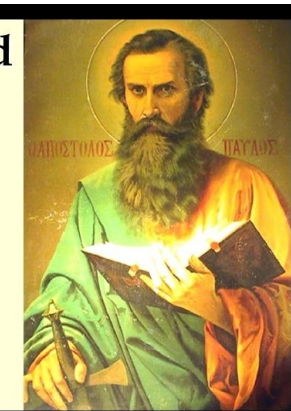
**Family of the Month (July)**
