TO THE
SACRED HEART OF JESUS**



Leader (Greeting): My dear brothers & sisters in Christ let us begin our Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus... *IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, AND OF THE SON, AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.*

All: AMEN.

L: God, come to our assistance;

All: Lord, make haste to help us.

L: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

All: As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be world without end. Amen.

Song (related to the Sacred Heart):

L & All (all kneel)....:

CONSECRATION

O Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing. I adore you, I love you, and with a lively sorrow for my sins, I offer you this poor heart of mine.

Make me humble, patient, pure, and wholly obedient to your will.

Grant that I may live in you and for you.

Protect me in the midst of danger, comfort me in my afflictions, give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen.

INDULGENCED EJACULATIONS

O Most Merciful Jesus, we consecrate ourselves today and always to Your Most Sacred Heart.

Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like Your Heart. (*Indulgence of 500 days, no.227*)

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus we implore, that we may ever love You more and more.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, we trust in You!

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us! (*Indulgence of 500 days. No. 242*).

NOVENA PRAYER

Divine Jesus,/ You have said,/ "Ask, and you shall receive;/ seek, and you shall find;/ knock, and it shall be opened unto you,"/ behold me, kneeling at Your Feet,/filled with a lively faith and confidence/ in the promises dictated by Your Sacred Heart/ and pronounced by Your adorable lips./ I come to ask this favor:/ (*Here silently mention your petitions.*)

To whom can I turn if not to You/ whose Heart is the source of all graces and merits?/ Where should I seek if not in the treasure/which contains all the

riches of Your kindness and mercy?/
Where must I knock / if not at the door
through which God gives Himself to us/
and through which we go to God?/ I
have recourse to You, Heart of Jesus./
In You I find consolation when
afflicted,/ protection when persecuted,/
strength when burdened with trials,/
and light in doubt and darkness.

Dear Jesus,/ I firmly believe/ that
You can grant me the grace I implore,/
even though it should require a
miracle./ You have only to will it,/ and
my prayer will be granted/ I admit that
I am most unworthy of Your favors,/ but
this is not a reason for me to be
discouraged./ You are the God of
mercy/ and You will not refuse a
contrite heart./ Cast upon me a look of
mercy,/ I beg of You,/ and Your kind
Heart will find in my miseries and
weakness/ a reason for granting my
prayer.

O Sacred Heart,/ whatever may be
Your decision with regard to my
request,/ I will never stop adoring,
loving, praising, and serving You./ My
Jesus,/be pleased to accept this my act
of perfect resignation/ to the decrees of
Your adorable Heart/ which I sincerely
desire may be fulfilled in and by me and
all Your creatures forever.

Sacred Heart of Jesus,/ I know that
there is but one thing impossible to
You:/ to be without pity for those who
are suffering or in distress./ Look upon
me,/ I beg of You, dear Jesus,/ and
grant me the grace for which I humbly
implore You/ through the Immaculate
heart of Your most sorrowful Mother./
You have entrusted me to her as her

child,/and her prayers are all powerful
with You. Amen.

their eternal glory in heaven.

PROMISES OF OUR LORD



"I promise you, in the excessive mercy
of my heart that my all-powerful love
will grant to all those who receive
Holy Communion on the First Friday for
nine consecutive months, the grace of
final repentance; they shall not die
in my disgrace nor without receiving
the sacraments; my divine Heart shall
be their safe refuge in that last
moment."

1. I will give them all the graces
necessary for their state in life.
2. I will give peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their
troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an
assured refuge during life and
especially at the hour of death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on
all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the
source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise
to great perfection.

9. I will bless the homes in which the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and honoured.

10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.

11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their name written in My Heart, and it shall never be effaced.

12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under My displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Heart shall be their assured refuge at the last hour.

The Twelve Promises Of the Sacred Heart to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque

Image - Holy Communion - First Fridays



Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary and revealed the devotions to His Sacred Heart. She was favoured with many apparitions, the most special ones took place between 1673 and 1675.

They took place as St. Margaret was praying before the Blessed Sacrament and Our Lord revealed all the Love that is enclosed in His Sacred Heart for humanity. He requested her to receive Him in Holy Communion of the first Friday of every month and to meditate the passion on Thursdays between 11 and 12 p.m.

"And He showed me that it was His great desire of being loved by men and of withdrawing them from the path of ruin into which Satan hurls such crowds of them, that made Him form the design of manifesting His Heart to men."

As Good Catholics, we should honour the Sacred Heart of Jesus by doing this devotion for 9 consecutive Fridays and then by attending Holy Communion as often as possible, daily if our gift is such, we must enthrone an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in our homes as Our King and also an image of the Immaculate Heart of Mary our Mother and Queen.

We should also practice devotions to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the First Saturdays of the months as she has requested through Sister Lucy.
