Post Admittance Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that members of Post 62 are afforded the best opportunity to enjoy the benefits of their membership and to allow reasonable access to members of other veterans' organizations and to guests.

1. All Post 62 American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary (ALA), and Sons of the American Legion (SAL) members must show their current membership card for admittance to the Post when requested. Those whose membership status is not current will be offered the opportunity to bring their membership to current paid status so that they may be admitted to the Post.
2. Members of American Legion, ALA, or SAL Posts other than Post 62 must show a current membership card for their Post, sign the Post 62 guest book, and may sign in up to one (1) guest, including their spouse, who is not a member of the Legion, ALA, or SAL.
3. Members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), AMVETS, or the Disabled American Veterans (DAV) must show a current membership card for their organization and sign the Post 62 guest book. They may sign in one (1) guest who is not a current member of their recognized organization or its auxiliary.
4. Post 62 members may sign in up to two (2) guests each; however, if a guest is eligible for membership in the American Legion, ALA, or SAL, they may only be signed in a maximum of three (3) times per calendar year. After that, they must join one of the organizations to be readmitted to the Post.
5. An exception to item number 4 is when Post 62 members host an authorized card game or event at the Post and sign players or attendees in for the express purpose of participating in or attending that authorized game or event.
6. Any exceptions to the above-listed items will be made by the Post 62 American Legion Commander, Vice Commander, or senior Post 62 Officer present at the time needed or, if no Officer is present, by the bartender on duty.

This policy is the responsibility of the Post 62 American Legion Officers. Staff will assist in the implementation of this policy.

ATTENTION SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION, SQUADRON 62 MEMBERS!

Due to the increased cost of first-class stamps, the Sons voted to institute the following policy for the distribution of all membership cards, effective July 1, 2025:

If your official address of record is:

- In Martin County or the cities of Port St. Lucie, Tequesta, or Jupiter, you must pick up your card at the Post unless you specifically ask that it be mailed to you.
- In Florida but is NOT located in one of the above-listed areas, we will mail your card to you unless you specifically ask to pick it up at the Post.
- Out of state because you are a seasonal resident, your card will be mailed to that address unless you provide a local address. If you provide a local address, you must pick up your card up at the Post unless you specifically ask that it be mailed to the local address.

Membership renewals are usually processed within 7 to 10 days of receipt, and membership cards are available for pick up or are mailed within that time frame. If your card is mailed, please allow an additional 5 to 7 days for the US Postal Service to deliver it.

PLEASE PROVIDE US WITH YOUR NEW ADDRESS IF YOU MOVE SO WE CAN UPDATE YOUR FILE IN OUR DATABASE.

ATTENTION MEMBERS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION, POST 62!

Due to the cost of first-class mail and the need for you to pick up your key card for our new security system, **I will no longer mail local membership cards.** If you live within 20 miles of Post 62, you should pick up your membership card at the Post. If you need to receive your key card, please see the schedule posted elsewhere in these announcements.

If your mailing address is more than 20 miles from Stuart or if you are a “snowbird” with an out-of-state address and renew your dues, I will mail your membership card to you. You may contact me at the phone number shown below when you return to the Stuart area to make an appointment to pick up your key card.

It normally takes 10 to 14 days for National to process your membership payment. If I am able, I will have your card available at the Post prior to that deadline.

IF YOU MOVE, PLEASE LET ME KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE SO I CAN UPDATE YOUR RECORDS IN THE DATABASE. PLEASE PROVIDE ME WITH YOUR PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS, IF YOU HAVE NOT, SO I CAN CONTACT YOU IN CASE THERE IS AN ISSUE THAT I NEED TO ADDRESS WITH YOU.

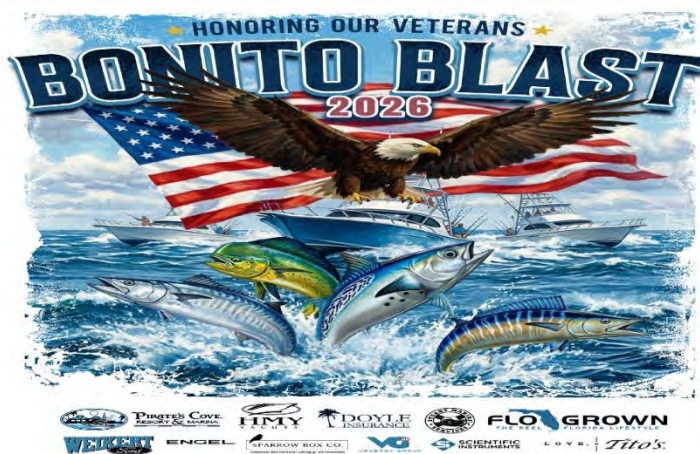

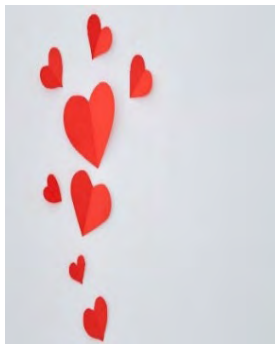

Our official membership goal (number of paid members expected by June 30, 2026) was 1,103. We ended with a total of 1,144 paid members by that date. Yeah!!!

Each year, National HQ usually adds 3% to the previous year's goal to set the goal for the new year. 3% of 1,103 is 34 members.

1,103 + 34 = 1,137 – This will most likely be our next membership goal.

50% of 1,137 is **568**; THIS is the number of paid members that National and the Department expect us to have NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 7, 2026.

AS OF 07/26/2026 WE HAVE 359 PAID MEMBERS FOR 2027. WE NEED 209 MORE BEFORE SEPTEMBER 7. PLEASE RENEW YOUR MEMBERSHIP NOW!!!

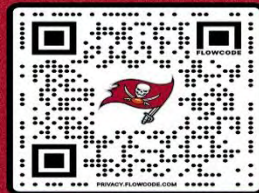

Legionnaires and Sons! If you have not already created a **MyLegion.Org** account, please do so at <https://www.mylegion.org/>.

Click **REGISTER** in the blue streamer and follow the instructions to create your personal **MyLegion.Org** account. Then you will be able to update your personal information (phone number, address, etc.), check your membership status, **renew your membership**, and **PRINT A DUPLICATE MEMBERSHIP CARD IF YOU LOSE YOURS**.

To Renew your **American Legion** OR **Sons of The American Legion** membership, go to www.legion.org, select the **RENEW** button, enter your membership number and last name, then review your information and make and submit corrections as needed. On the next page, enter your debit/credit card information to pay your membership fee for The American Legion or The Sons of The American Legion.

American Legion members may now renew their membership for **three years at a time and lock in their current membership dues rate**. (This may be an option for the Sons in the future.) To take advantage of this option, you **MUST** do so from the **national American Legion website** at www.legion.org/renew. **Lock in your current membership rate NOW!**

To renew your American Legion Auxiliary membership, go to www.alaforveterans.org and follow the instructions to pay the \$45.00 membership fee. *Please note that it may take 2 to 4 weeks before the local Unit receives notification of your renewal and is able to issue your new membership card.* If you need assistance or notice a mistake on your card after you receive it, contact Auxiliary Membership Chair Nancy Ann Taylor at 772-341-8151.

You may also mail your Legion, Sons, or Auxiliary payment to or drop it off at The American Legion Harold Johns Post 62, 2000 SE Fischer Street, Stuart, FL 34997 (please include a legible phone number and email address in case we need to contact you with questions.) Your membership card will be mailed to you at the address on file, unless you provide a different address, or you may ask to pick it up at the Post.

Ask your bartender or an Auxiliary officer to laminate your card (free for Legion members/\$1.00 for Sons and Auxiliary members.)

Don't forget to sign your card before it is laminated!
