Eligibility Requirements:

- Valid Passport
- CV/Resume
- Registered Nurse with Bachelors Degree
- Registered Psychiatric Nurse with Bachelors Degree
- Midwife with Diploma or Bachelors Degree
- Enrolled Nurse Assistance with a Diploma

License Requirements:

You must have an active nurse council license based on your home country. The following fields that do not require an active license are:
