OUR PRESCHOOLER PROGRAMS



READY SET DANCE is a one hour combo class of JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, SINGING and MUSIC.

Designed for both boys and girls, the program focuses on teaching the fundamentals of dance while developing confidence, coordination and creativity in a professional and safe environment.

All these ingredients together create a super hour of fun!



READY SET MOVE is a creative movement and music class for toddlers from walking to 3 years of age, and their grown up for a 45 minute class.

The class consists of 3 sections - ENGAGE, EXPLORE AND EXPRESS.

Participating in READY SET MOVE with the support of a grown up can make a significant contribution to play, development and learning. So come and bounce like a bunny, be slow like a sloth and create memories with your special little mover.



Ready Set Acro is a collaborative acrobatic program developed with Industry Leader Acrobatic Arts, specifically designed for preschoolers. It emphasises safe and effective progressions to foster the physical and social skills needed for healthy early childhood development. The program is developed with original music with lyric cues and focuses on three key components: Stretch, Strength, and Skills.

The guided training and structured approach allows instructors to successfully conduct a dynamic and engaging preschool acrobatics class that not only promotes holistic developmental milestones but teaches a range of exciting AcroDance Skills. 40 minutes



READY SET BALLET is 45 minute magical ballet experience for 2- 5 year olds where they learn the fundamentals of classical ballet.

FAQ'S



Can I watch my child's classes?

In our experience preschoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and other siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As preschoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. Our program allows parents to watch the first class if necessary to help them adjust.

Are your teacher's qualified?

All teachers have their Working with Children Check (or equivalent) and follow the program that is endorsed by early learning experts. Ready Set Dance teachers are required to gain their certification from Ready Set Dance head office before delivering the program.

Do we need to purchase uniform and shoes?

Students must wear the Ready Set Dance uniform. However, we need to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before committing to anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official Ready Set Dance uniform at reception which we are sure you will love.

What is watching day?

Watching day is where parents get to view their child dance as an audience in the classroom. It's a chance for your child to begin their first step to working on their performance skills.

If we miss a class can it be made up on another day of the week?

You may swap days during Terms 1, 2 and 3 if you miss a class (as long as the make up class is not full). In term 4, each class works on a different routine for the end-of-year concert, and it is too confusing for students to be swapping days. We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as preschoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

How can I experience Ready Set Dance at home?

Ready Set Dance airs on Nick Jr and Paramount Plus. You can also catch us on YouTube and the Nick Jr Play App. The Show has been so popular that it is now airing in 120 countries all over the world. Preschoolers love to dance along to their favourite songs from the TV show in their classes every week.



FAQ'S



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE CLASSES?

Ready Set Move is an inclusive program that welcomes all grown ups. Mums, dads, grandparents and special friends can all join in the fun. We do ask that only ONE grown up accompanies each toddler to help us abide by space restrictions and requirements. Grown ups need to be physically able to sit on the ground, get up and down off the floor and lead toddlers through the exercises.

WHAT AGE GROUP DOES THIS CLASS CATER FOR?

This program is designed for toddlers/preschoolers from walking age to 3 years who are more comfortable attending class with a grown up.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE CLASS?

The beginning of the class is the most structured part of the lesson. This circle time includes knee bounce nursery rhymes, the stretchy band, parachute fun and even some toddler aerobics. The next part of the class is a time for toddlers to be creative and use their imaginations playing instruments and our favourite themed dice game. In the third part toddlers love to crawl through tunnels, balance on beams and explore a variety of different activities around the room. The class concludes with a calm and connect song with our giant feathers or bubbles leading into sticker time.

WHAT WILL MY TODDLER LEARN?

The class has been created by experienced dance professionals, professional songwriters and early learning experts. There are benefits in every song! Our original mirror song is designed to teach toddlers the 16 hand gestures they should be developing by 16 months.

FEE POLICIES



BANK ACCOUNT -

Payment via bank transfer will no longer be accepted.

PAYRIX -

All payments from now on will need to be made through the Payrix system on the parent portal. Those that already use this system will need to re-fill out the required forms as its now under new names.

Payments on Payrix can be made in full or part payments.

Families who attend 2 class or more a week and wish to pay off an invoice through out the term MUST be done through Payrix. Payment plans are available through the parent portal. These need to be set up prior to the term commencing. To set this up log into the parent portal -> my account -> payment details. This will then send your request to our receptionist and they will contact you about the payment plan.

DISCOUNT CODE - 5% discount for full payment of term 3 invoice before the due date. This code is available for anyone to use when paying through Payrix only. This is a discount for those that wish to pay their account IN FULL before the due date and can not to be used on part payments.

When paying enter code = EARLYBIRD

PARENT PORTAL -

If you haven't set up your parent portal log in before, you may need the code which is G8CBKMWT. Visit the Jazz Attack website and click Parent Portal. If it shows a think smart logo you'll need to click code and add the above code. If it shows the Jazz Attack logo, you can either log in or create a new account. When creating a new account you need to make sure you use the same email address you have supplied us with (this email address your invoice is coming to), that way your accounts will match up to one another.

TERM DATES

The calendar for dancing follows the school calendar. Therefore the dates for the dancing year are as follows:
