## RACE FOR EDUCATION

In May, Pastor Wesley returned to the United States to outreach on behalf on Path to Salvation.

On Wednesday, May 04, Pastor Wesley arrived in NC. Thursday morning, Wesley was able to share his testimony to the high schoolers at Gaston Christian School. He encouraged these students to reflect on their lives and to be sure they knew the Lord and His saving grace.

The main reason for Wesley's visit was to be present for the The Khaleda Run on Saturday. Blindsight, Inc., a 501c3 organization, raises funds each year by putting on The Khaleda Run. The proceeds raised are then spent on either Vision Care or Literacy Programs. This year, Blindsight, Inc. was generous in helping Path to Salvation, Inc. kick off a new Education Program for the 2022–2023 school year, where children will have the opportunity to go to school.

#### Tell us a little bit about yourself.

I grew up in a non-Christian family. We were poor. We were lucky if we had one meal a day. I have three brothers and three sisters.

When I was 15, my mom got very sick. I felt completely discouraged because we had to sell our possessions to buy medicine. I made a vow to the Lord, if He would heal my mom, I will serve Him all the rest of my life. My mom was instantaneously healed!

A couple years later, I had a dream and a pastor said this is the last day you have to receive Jesus. You see, I accepted the Lord a few years ago, but I never took the commitment seriously. Now, I knew I had to find a good church and take my life seriously.

I visited many churches, and met Pastor Wesley when he was a senior Pastor at Grace Church. I knew this church was a church of God and Pastor Wesley shares the Truth. I established a friendship with Pastor Wesley. He began to teach me how to live in faith. Wesley encouraged me to believe in men, not God.

When Pastor Wesley left Grace Church, I knew I had to follow him. I knew I needed to learn more about Jesus because I knew Jesus was so alive in Pastor Wesley.

#### What is your role at PTS?

I play the guitar on the worship team and I preach the second Sunday of the month. Each Sunday afternoon, I lead the evangelist team and we go out to visit people in their homes to share the Good News and to pray for them.
