“Why” Proper Securement Matters

- Prevent injuries during sudden stops or collisions .
- Comply with state and federal safety regulations.
- Protect the child and reduce liability.

What does good seat belt fit look like?

<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ The shoulder belt should be across the middle of the chest and shoulder.✓ The lap belt should be across the upper thighs.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✗ The shoulder belt is too close to or on the neck or face; or too far out on shoulder.✗ The lap belt is across the stomach.

Keep children properly buckled in the back seat until age 13.

- Harness Systems: For younger or special - needs students.
- Booster Seats: For children who outgrow harnesses but need belt positioning.
- Buckle Guards: Prevent accidental unbuckling during transport
- Standard Seat Belts: For older students





Common Mistakes

- Chest clip too low or high
- Lap belt across stomach
- Shoulder Belt behind back or under arm
- Lose harness straps

Good Seat Belt Fit With High-Back Booster Seat




Always properly buckle children aged 12 and under in the back seat!
