

HOUSING:

30 in L x 12 in H minimum enclosure

TEMP & HUMIDITY:

Cool zone temperature - 70-77 degrees F

Hot zone temperature - 85-90 degrees F Basking zone temperature - 90-95 degrees F

Low Humidity -

**A Humid Hide should be provided near the middle/cool end of the enclosure (bumping up the humidity of the entire enclosure could cause respiratory issues)

30-40%

SIZE & LIFESPAN:

7-9 inches

Average lifespan in captivity is 10-20 years

FEEDING:

Live crickets, mealworms, hornworms, dubia & discoid roaches, silkworms, black soldier fly larvae

AND

Main diet should consist of a variety of live insects, dusted with calcium/vitamin supplement, offered every 3-5 days for adults; juveniles can be fed daily

Other insects such as super worms, wax worms and butter worms given as treats.
