Tongue depressors/popsicle sticks

Small bandage scissors

Cotton balls/pads

Locking hemostats

Activated charcoal

Silver sulfadiazine ointment

Povidone iodine solution

Hydrogen peroxide

Eye wash solution

Cornstarch

Eyedropper

**Syringes** 

Paper towels

Clean towels

Heating pad

Pedialyte

Handfeeding formula

Flashlight

Travel carrier
