

Pet First Aid Kit

Below is a list of items that could be used to provide first aid for an injured pet until they can be taken in for examination by a veterinarian. Always contact a veterinarian for emergencies such as serious injuries or illness as soon as possible.

Disposable gloves

Antiseptic wipes (for sanitizing human hands)

Sterile nonstick gauze pads

Elastic gauze bandage

Non-woven surgical tape

Tongue depressors/popsicle sticks

Small bandage scissors

Cotton balls/pads

Cotton swabs

Tweezers

Locking hemostats

Activated charcoal

Silver sulfadiazine ointment

Povidone iodine solution

Hydrogen peroxide

Eye wash solution

Cornstarch

Eyedropper

Syringes

Paper towels

Clean towels

Heating pad

Pedialyte

Handfeeding formula

Flashlight

Travel carrier
