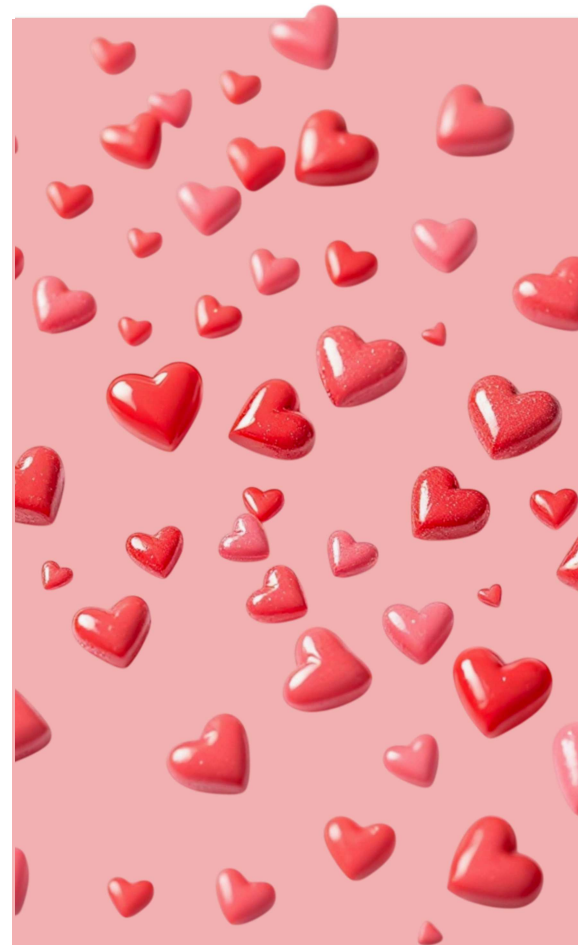

Scriptural reference - Psalm 51

Sorors, as this is being published, we are into the season of Lent according to the Christian calendar. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday when we are invited to receive imposition of ashes on our foreheads.

This is a visible sign of our own mortality and the reminder that we have come from dust and that we will return to dust. Typically, depending on your denominational tradition, during the 40-46 days preceding Easter Sunday when we celebrate the resurrection of our Risen Savior, we are called to Fast, Pray and give alms to prepare ourselves for Renewal. In the church where I grew up, "fast" was interpreted as sacrifice and involved "giving up something for Lent." This meant that people abstained from bad/unhealthy habits like smoking, or consuming/indulging in something that brought them pleasure such as red meat on Fridays, desserts, movies. To this self-confessed chocoholic, my go-to sacrifice was usually chocolate. A common tool of almsgiving was Lenten folders into which we inserted a dime for each day of Lent -- Inflation later dictated that the little slots in the folders were enlarged to accommodate quarters. During this season of High Holy Days, consider fasting from and fasting to: Fasting from hateful words, pettiness, gossip, greed, indifference, selfishness, vindictiveness, and fasting to intentional self-reflection, honoring commitments, kindness, thoughtful actions, peace, generosity, inclusion, self-care (since you cannot pour out of an empty cup), service and Love. Thus, we live out our devotion to God and honor the promises that we make each time we recite our pledge to our beloved sisterhood in Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority. Think on these Things
