A. Discussion with Possible Action High Ammonia at the Public School

 - 1. DNR Inspection Update for WWTP draft plans are complete and ready to be submitted to the DNR upon approval. Tim would like to send it to the DNR before having a Public Hearing. It takes 30 to 60 days and possibly 90 days. The new plan will take care of all the problems we need to get resolved. The Plan consists of a new aeration basin, selector tank, new control room, blowers, laboratory, controls, garage, new chemical feed building, headwork, pumps, package treatment system, disinfection, digester, sludge thickening and storage systems.
 - 2. Double Tank wall Tim from Davy said since we do have a plan, we may be able to hold off on the double wall tank. Tim suggested waiting to see what the DNR tells us if the tank is not leaking.
