Only dogs registered with UKC or with a temporary listing number may participate in the trial.

Pre-Entry Fee: \$28 for each run per element
\$100 4 elements (1 run ea), same dog, same trial
\$200 for entire weekend- 4 elements all trials (8 runs), same dog
SENIOR SPECIAL (65+) - \$21 per element or \$84 4 elements, same dog, same trial or \$168 for entire weekend - 4 elements all trials (8 runs), same dog
PLEASE write "senior handler" on the registration form.
JR Handler - \$13 per element.

- Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to exhibitor.
- Use one form per dog.
- Incomplete entry forms will not be processed.

If the judging limit of 8 hours is reached before entries close, a wait list will be established. If you are unable to attend, please tell the Trial Secretary. **If there is a wait list, a refund will be given if your spot can be filled.**

- Pre-entry Confirmations will be sent via e-mail as soon as possible after receipt of Pre-Entries.
- If you have not received confirmation by one week prior to the trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- Entries are excepted in the order they are received (not random draw)

Trials 1 & 2 will follow the schedule below.

Move-ups for Trial 2 **MUST** be made immediately after the qualifying run in Trial 1.

Saturday Trial 1 Container & Exterior start at the same time

The running order for both will be Novice A and B, Advanced A and B, Superior, Master, and Elite.

Saturday Trial 2 Container & Exterior start at the same time after the completion of Trial 1 and will follow the same running order

Sunday Trial 1 Interior & Vehicle start at the same time

The running order for both will be Novice A and B, Advanced A and B, Superior, Master, and Elite.

Sunday Trial 2 Interior & Vehicle start at the same time after the completion of Trial 1 and will follow the same running order.

- Awards:**
- A placement ribbon will be offered for first through fourth in each class in each trial.
 - A qualifying ribbon will be presented to all qualifiers .
 - New title ribbons will be offered for element titles and class titles.

Refund Policy

- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or the trial is canceled because of storms or other conditions beyond the control of Paws For Fun.
- After closing, no refunds will be given except for bitches in season or a medical issue. In these cases, a veterinarian's note will be required.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial judges and/or trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Please be considerate of others and clean up after your dog at the trial site and motel facilities. Owners/handlers not cleaning up after their dogs are subject to dismissal from the trial without refund.

Notice to Exhibitors

- By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
- By entering the trials you agree that the UKC, Paws For Fun, and Warren County Fair Grounds are not responsible for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury. UKC, Paws For Fun, and Warren County are not responsible for loss, accidents, or theft. By entering the trial, the participant waives all rights which he/she or their family may have or hereafter against Paws for Fun and the Property Owners for occurrences over the trial weekend.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed on the premises.
- Dogs must be kept on leash in the building and outside, unless otherwise directed.
- NO alcohol, illegal drugs, or SMOKING permitted on the grounds
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Directions once at the grounds:

Pull into Fairgrounds Rd and make an immediate right, driving between the Flea Market and Rt 522. Follow around passed the barn to the parking area. We will also have signs to follow.

Grounds Information

The barn building will open at 8am. Check in begins at 8:45am. A general briefing will follow the handler discrimination trial.

There will be limited indoor crating available.

Dogs who can not "shush" should be crated in their vehicle.

The Flea Market will be open during our event.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the site. There is ample walking area on the grounds. We will have pick up bags and trash cans available for disposal. Please use them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Lunch

Lunch will be provided by Paws For Fun for workers as a "thank you." Non-workers may also enjoy the lunch for a \$5 donation. There are also various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance. No large coolers allowed in the facility.

Camping

Dry camping is available for \$35 for the weekend. If interested, please let Connie Moss, the Trial Chair, know 2 weeks prior to the trial. Overnight security is not provided.

- Elements are divided into Levels "N"- "E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. Be sure to check the rules regarding the divisions. For these classes, dogs will only be searching the elements chosen.
- Handler Discrimination. In Novice, Advanced, and Excellent, one glove must be provided by the handler. In Master level classes a personal item according to the rules for this level.
- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Nosework Trial Entry Form".
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Nosework events are open to all UKC registered breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Performance Listing/ Limited Privilege number/Permanent Registration/Temporary Listing.
- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- The United Kennel Club complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require an accommodation, please contact the Event Chair or Secretary for this club's event.

WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club.
