Also, thanks to Jim Cort for conducting the raffle for us.

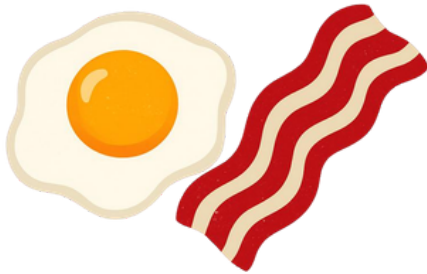
HELPING HANDS

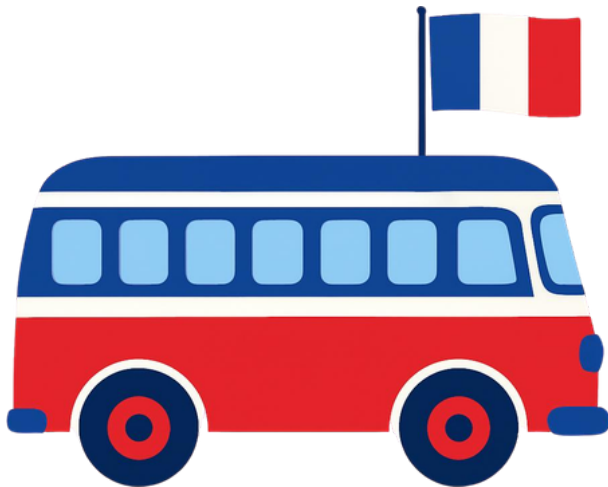


Montreal Passport Reminder:

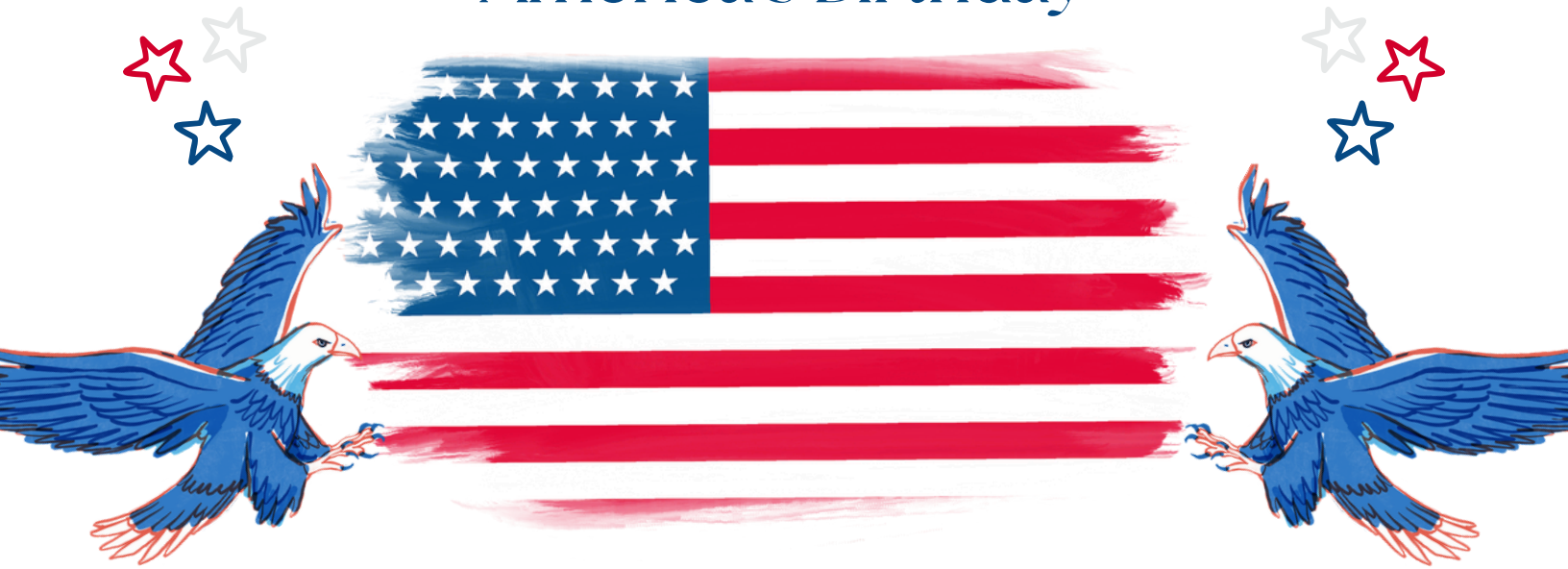

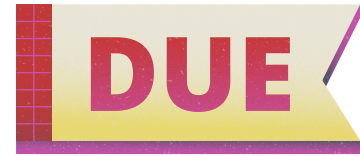
