



Seniors Age 75 and Older Can Register to Receive the COVID-19 vaccine now!

Appointments are now being made in our area.

How to register:

- Register online with the Vaccine Administration Management System at <https://dphsubmissions.ct.gov/OnlineVaccine> or by telephone at **877-918-2224**.
- The current priority for appointments is for those 75 and up. People age 65 and older, and younger adults with co-morbidities will be eligible soon.
- Once you register with VAMS, *you must check your email regularly.* Appointments will be offered and you can confirm them via email. If you register via phone, stay in
- All information you share while registering with VAMS will be kept private and only used to make your appointment.
- When you make register with VAMS you will be contacted by a VAMS rep (if by phone) or email (if online) and asked to create an account with the CDC. Once that is done, you will have access to available appointments.
- If you need assistance in registering online with VAMS (but you have an email address), Woodbury Senior Center can help. Call us at (203) 263-2828.

Where to find your vaccine:

- The VAMS system will help you locate an appointment in our area.

- Coming soon: Once released at the community level, many pharmacies will also be offering covid vaccine to eligible persons. Woodbury Drug, CVS, and Walgreens will be participating, among others.
