## Woodbury Senior Center Standard Transportation

This service offers senior bus, lift -  
equipped transportation on a  
schedule for getting around town,  
personal shopping and errands.  
Transportation to and from Senior  
Center daily, weekdays.  
Eligibility - over 60 with or without a  
disability, or over 18 with a disability.  
Free service; donations accepted.

Shopping and errands as follows:  
Mondays: Woodbury or neighboring  
towns for big store shopping  
Tuesdays: Woodbury  
Wednesdays: Woodbury, Southbury  
and outings (see monthly calendar  
for details)  
Thursdays: Woodbury  
Friday: Southbury

# Woodbury Senior Center Non-Urgent Medical Appointment Transportation

This service offers door to door transportation on a lift-equipped senior bus to area medical offices by appointment.

Eligibility - over 60 with or without a disability, or over 18 with a disability. Free service; donations accepted.

Transportation will be available for non-urgent medical appointments as follows:

Mondays and Wednesdays -  
Waterbury, Middlebury and Watertown

Tuesdays, Thursdays & Fridays -  
Woodbury and Southbury

Please make your appointments accordingly - ideally between 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. We do not provide transportation for medical procedures.

# GWTD Dial-A-Ride Program

This free service allows riders to go anywhere in the 8-town Greater Waterbury Transit District (GWTD) on Wednesdays. Towns include Woodbury, Cheshire, Middlebury, Naugatuck, Prospect, Waterbury, Watertown, and Wolcott. Riders must pre-register with Woodbury Department of Senior Service before making reservations. Eligibility - over 60 with or without a disability, or over 18 with a disability.

Reservations accepted up to 14 days in advance. Have your Ride ID handy when calling for reservations; be sure to book two rides - one to get where you are going, and one to get back home.

# Fee-for-Service Transportation

There are several transportation companies that will provide you with a ride for a fee. Some of the services are limited to ambulatory riders, while others provide lift-equipped vehicles. Rideshare services are sometimes available. Rides are available for all ages.

Also, certain medical providers and/or advocacy organizations provide some transportation, such as a ride for a cancer patient to cancer treatment.
