Dust Control: The Albion Township will be spraying certain roads that we have listed on the map located at the Town Hall bulletin board. If you live on a road that was selected to be sprayed.

Dust Control application will be available to all Albion Township Residents on a sign-up basis. The cost is \$110 for up to 300 feet per parcel, \$146 for up to 400 feet, \$183 for up to 500 feet additional material can be purchased for \$0.73 per foot. If you wish to take advantage of this service, please make a check payable to Albion Township and mail to 2235 Co Rd 6 NW, Annandale MN 55302, deadline to sign up is **May 3rd, 2025**. Please note that we will only match residents on Township maintained roads.

Road Right Away: The Township Road right-of-way is usually 66 feet (33 feet from the center of any road or highway) any crops planted in the right-of-way would be violation of Minnesota Statute §160.2715. If you have questions, please contact us.

Recycling

- Have recycling carts set out no later than 5:00am.
- Only what fits in the cart will be picked up and needs to be in a Mumford recycling cart only.
- The front side of the recycling cart needs to face the street.
- Clearance of 4 feet on all sides from other carts, buildings, parked cars, trees, mailbox, etc.
- Lids on the cart must be completely closed for the cart to be emptied.
- If stored outside, keep the lid of the cart securely closed to prevent recycling from blowing out of the cart and to keep rain and snow from accumulating inside the cart.
- Do not use rope or bungee straps to keep the lid closed.
- Each household is responsible for clearing snow and ice from around the carts.
- Carts cannot be placed on top of snowbank for collection.

Recycling is taken to the McLeod County recycling center, where it is sorted and distributed. The more we recycle the better for the environment and it can even reduce your garbage bill.

If you need a bin, please leave a message at the hall 320-963-5667, we will distribute them as we can get the carts.

Recycling calendars are mailed the beginning of April every year. The Township pays \$16,401 per year to have recycling service.

All Recycling must be cleaned/rinsed.

The following items are recyclable:

Aluminum beverage cans, metal food cans; glass bottles and jars (all colors); plastic containers and lids #1 through #7; cartons – milk, soup, broth, wine, juice boxes; egg cartons; newspaper & inserts; corrugated cardboard, boxboard (cereal, cracker, shoe boxes); mixed mail (magazines, office paper, envelopes); shredded paper in a paper bag.

The following are not recyclable:

Ceramic or porcelain; food soiled paper, pizza boxes; gift wrap paper; plastic bags; plastic hangers; mirror or plate glass; drinking glasses, used paper towels; metal car parts; motor oil/jugs; Styrofoam; window glass; plastic bags.
