The Township regularly trims brush in the road right-of-way and ditches for safety purposes. If anyone has concerns, please call a board official.

It is unlawful to plow snow onto or across Township roads, according to Mn. State Statute 160-2715. Violation of this statute is a misdemeanor offense.

The Township road right-of-way is usually 66 feet (33 feet from the center of the road.) A good rule of thumb: keep <u>everything</u> back 15 feet from the edge of the right-of-way.
