MONTHLY BOARD MEETING
Tuesday May 20th, 2025

Meeting: The meeting was called to order at 7pm. Members present Bob Neumann Chair, Chad Walhowe Vice Chair, John Uecker Supervisor, Jami Berg Treasurer, Debbie Uecker Clerk & no residents.

Pledge of Allegiance: Recited.

Meeting Minutes: A motion to accept April 15th, 2025, monthly meeting minutes was made by John Uecker, 2nd by Chad Walhowe and carried 3-0.

Treasurers Report: The ending balance for April is \$319,687.08, subtract the outstanding checks we have an actual balance of \$318,958.37 and deposits of \$5,757.05 from Junk Amnesty Day, assessment search, scrap metal and dust control. A motion to accept the Treasurers' report was made by John Uecker, 2nd by Chad Walhowe and carried 3-0.

Maintenance Update:

Dust controlled 30th Street, Iresfeld, Keats, Klever, Gowan, 5th, Hoyt, 20th, Greer, Hendricks & 50th, with about 50% completed.

Graveled Illsley & Highland, New Loader arrived 2 weeks ago.

Next month: grading, packing & dust control.

Need to address sink hole on the corner of Hoyt Ave near section 35.

A motion was made by Bob Neumann, 2nd by Chad Walhowe to give authority to John & Gage to investigate the culvert, find a contractor & replace the culvert on Hoyt Ave in section 35 and carried 3-0.

Culvert on 10th Street on section line 27 & 34 needs to be looked at.

Discussed fires sign replacement or adding stickers to existing signs.

Old Business:

1) Chad Walhowe met with Bogart & Pederson and the contractor and completed a final punch list.

2) 25th Street and it will be completed in 2025.

3) Bogart and Pederson sent the legal description on T413 road vacation, and it will be recorded.

4) Received an estimate from Lindberg Excavating Inc on 50th Street. Bob questioned if we could perform the work ourselves with the front-end loader. John stated that we will need rocks placed to keep the erosion under control. Chad would like to get the project completed; we have a lot of money into it. A motion was made by Chad Walhowe, 2nd by John Uecker to hire Lindberg Excavating Inc for a total of \$10,527 with the option to start 80' from the intersection to eliminate \$1,200 for total cost of \$9,327. Motion carries is 2-1 with Supervisor Neumann opposed to the project. Discussion on the project.

New Business:

1) Dust Control List was reviewed.

2) Debbie applied for \$509.75 for clean-up day reimbursement from Wright County.

3) Discussed Recycling not going down Knox Ave.
