# **ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL**

### This Week's Lesson

Heeding Wholly - Matthew 11:7-15,20-24

Today's Lesson examines a time after John's ministry as a wilderness preacher had ended. He had run afoul of the local leader, Herod Antipas, and ended up in prison. These events led John to having doubts about his cousin, Jesus, so he sent two of his disciples to Jesus to determine whether or not He was the Messiah. Jesus replies by pointing to the evidence of His miracles. Our text picks up after John's disciples leave and Jesus explains who John actually was, and chides the people who won't repent even after seeing the miracles He performed!
