# ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

### This Week's Lesson...

A Family's Example - Jeremiah 35:5-11

Jeremiah's 40-year prophetic ministry was to warn the people of Judah of God's judgement to come at the hands of the Babylonians. This was to happen because of the sinfulness and rebellion against the Lord. Today's lesson tells the story of the Rekabite family who had a family tradition of living as nomads and abstaining from wine, and this family always obeyed this command from their forefathers. Jeremiah tempted the family with drinking wine but they remained faithful to the family tradition. This story of faithfulness was inspiring to Jeremiah and stood as a stark contrast to the people of Judah who lived in sin and failed to repent of their wicked ways. This story should serve as an example to God's followers to remain steadfast in our obedience regardless of societal pressures. Hope to see you there!
