## **Introduction to Sunday's Worship**

Today we follow Christ from triumphal entry to the cross, each waypoint of the journey marked by Jesus' compassion for those who would betray, mock, accuse, or do violence to him. Though persecuted and beaten, Jesus the Son of God is not disgraced; instead, he asks forgiveness for those who put him to death. We have walked the Lenten pathway these forty days, each of us invited through baptism to "let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus." We enter this holy week accompanying Jesus to the cross with both grief and thanksgiving in our hearts, trusting in God's redeeming love.

Sunday Worship will be live-streamed on YouTube beginning at 9:45 on Sunday morning. An email with the link will be sent on Sunday morning. You can also watch a recorded version later by visiting our **YouTube Page.**



#### **Lesson Summary**

The Lamb is Worthy - Revelation 5:1-10

This week, we move into the Apostle John's vision of the Divine Throne Room! After Jesus' death, resurrection, and Ascension, we now see the location of the true and ultimate ruler of the universe. Chapter 5 starts with John in deep distress because no one is worthy of opening the scroll in God's right hand! His distress is short-lived, however, because the Lamb has triumphed and is able to open the scroll. When Jesus returns, we will serve as royal Priests: we will reign over the New Earth! God be praised for His many wondrous gifts!

Note: there will be no Sunday School on Easter Sunday, April 20, 2025.
