Deadline: This Sunday - February 2nd

In 1981 Saint James Lutheran along with six other local churches combined efforts to create Cooperative Christian Ministry to assist families in need for food and housing. This time of the year is



the highest demand for food items for the pantry. Scouting Pack and Troop 91 are hosting a food collection to supply the Cooperative Christian Ministry food pantry with non-perishable food supplies.

Items needed are:

- 1. Any canned meat or tuna
- 2. Soups, other than Tomato
- 3. Fruits, other than Pears
- 4. Oatmeal and Cereal (whole grain and low sugar, if possible)
- 5. All types of beans, other than Pintos
- 6. Pasta, especially Mac & Cheese
- 7. Toiletries, baby diapers, and paper products

Our group's goal is to collect 2000 pounds of food to deliver to CCM. <u>Please</u> consider clearing your cabinets, or purchasing items and placing them in the portico area by Sunday February 2nd.

You may also donate to CCM with a check that will go to purchase food items.
