When Amos reports his vision of God judging Israel for its mistreatment of the poor, he becomes a threat to the power of the priests and the king. John the Baptist also speaks truth to power, and Herod has him killed. In Herod's fear that Jesus is John returned from the dead, we may hear hope for the oppressed: all the prophets killed through the ages are alive in Jesus. We are called to witness to justice in company with them, and

to proclaim God's saving love.

Please consider volunteering for Videographer

Below is a brief run-down if you are considering volunteering to serve as videographer.

It is less intimidating than it sounds!

- 1 On Sunday, facing the pulpit, you would go into the left side door where the laptop is, log on, select the OBS icon and click "start streaming" and "start recording" between 9:45am - 10am.
- **2** From there, you can take the Android tablet to your seat and open the "PanTilt-Zoom" icon and zoom in/out as you wish (although not necessary if you wish to keep it at the wide angle shot).
- **3** At the end of the service you would return to the laptop, hit "stop streaming" and "stop recording" and exit out of the OBS program and log off the laptop.

John Patterson was kind enough to write up a stepby-step instruction sheet that sits beside the


Adult Vacation Bible School Opportunity

Registration is \$40/person or \$70/couple and includes programming and lunch for each day.



Cooperative Christian Ministry (CCM) announced the opening of the NEW My Father's House Annex facility in Kannapolis, N.C. The establishment of


