What we have, what we bring to Jesus' table, seems like it is not nearly enough to meet all the needs we see around us. But it is not the adequacy of our supplies or our skills that finally makes the difference: it is the power of Jesus working in

the littlest and least to transform this world into the world God desires, a world where all the hungry are satisfied.

Belltower Roof Update


This week, scaffolding went up around the Bell Tower to begin installation of the new roof. This aims to resolve stormwater issues within the tower, ensuring effective drainage. By utilizing scaffolding, workers will maintain operations and materials outside the church, promoting safer conditions. The chosen contractor, Murr & Laney, bring specialized expertise in historic church and home renovations across our region. Funding for the project comes from contributions by St. James members and support from the Cannon Foundation. The project is expected to conclude within 3 to 4 weeks, subject

to weather conditions.
