


EASTER SUNDAY

Today the Church completes its three great days of celebrating redemption. Since Maundy Thursday, we have been involved in an extended liturgy that will be brought to its conclusion today. This is the celebration of the Passover of Christ from death to life. It is also the celebration of our own Passover in Holy Baptism in which "we were buried with Christ in his death and raised with him." As we rejoice in our new life in the risen Christ on this day, he comes among us and is known to us in the Holy Scriptures, and we are sent forth to tell others of his resurrection.

available from the synod office and congregations across the synod as we move through Holy Week toward the celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord on Easter Day.


