### 3RD SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY

As we continue through the time after Epiphany, stories of the call to discipleship show us the implications of our baptismal calling to show Christ to the world. **Jesus** begins proclaiming the good news and calling people to repentance right after John the Baptist arrested is preaching in a similar way. Knowing that John was later executed, we see at the very outset the cost of discipleship. As always, we especially seek low sodium items, no-added-sugar items, and whole grain items.


