The Health and Safety Committee and Church Council strongly encourage everyone to wear masks during worship. There will be no congregational singing at this time.




OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

CCM FOOD PANTRY OCTOBER

In the CCM Food Program, we have become increasingly aware that there are some hard-working folks in our community who are still food-insecure.



Whether they are not being paid livable wages, or because of the skyrocketing housing costs, or for others reasons, they still face difficult decisions about food purchases and find themselves unable to adequately provide for their families. However, because of their work hours they are unable to visit our Crisis Center pantry during our regular hours, without taking time off from work (often unpaid). To alleviate this, we have decided to open up one evening a week. **Beginning November 4th we will reopen our Crisis Center drive-through pantry from 3:30 to 6:30 pm.** Obviously, this move will probably increase the overall demand for food.
