


#### CHRIST THE KING SUNDAY

### CCM FOOD PANTRY NOVEMBER

We have experienced a significant jump in the number of households seeking food assistance across the whole CCM Food Program (all pantries,



Samaritan's Table, etc.) this month. At the Crisis Center through this past Friday (10 service days) we have served 359 households representing 1,311 individuals (average family size 3.6!). Of those, 53 households (15%) had not been to CCM for assistance before! We are guessing that many more households are experiencing the squeeze of rapidly increasing rentals costs.
