

#### **FREE N95 MASKS**

We have received 600 free N95 masks from the NC Department of Health and Human Services. These will be available in the church office or in the Narthex on Sunday mornings. Each family will receive 5 masks initially. If we have leftovers then more will be available.



**NIOSH Approval:** The term "NIOSH approval" comes from the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH). For instance, an NIOSH-approved N95 boasts a 95% or greater efficiency rating, meaning that it blocks at least 95% of non-oil-based airborne particulate.


